

Holly Class Homework

In Holly class, the children will be set homework on a Friday, due to be handed in by the following Thursday. They can bring it in as soon as it is finished.

It will consist of:

- Reading at least three times a week - recorded in reading records and signed by an adult. The children will have their reading records checked once a week (Thursday) and get team points for each time they read - but it must be signed by an adult.
- Spelling Sheet - Please complete the spelling sheet, which will be linked to our learning from that week. Each week will be looking at a different spelling pattern following the Unlocking Spellings Scheme, which follows on from the Unlocking Letters and Sounds scheme, which they will have had in KS1.
- Times Tables - Please complete the club times tables sheet.

Please use Times Table Rockstars to practise times tables. This is particularly important for the Year 4 students who will be taking part in the Multiplication Check in the summer. The sound check function on TTRS replicates the test, so it is really useful to practise over the course of the year.
