

## English



Children will begin the term by studying the text Adolphus Tips by Michael Morpurgo using the text as inspiration for diary writing from a farm in WW2 to link with their WW2 history work. They will also study Anne Frank's diary and read As the Sky falls. Children will revisit and learn a wide range of grammar techniques which they will use to produce work in a variety of genres. Handwriting and spellings will be focused upon and children will be given spellings to learn at home which will be tested in class every week.

## Maths



Children will begin the Autumn term by focusing on the four operations – addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. They will compare and order fractions and work with equivalent fractions and mixed numbers. They will also add, subtract, divide and multiply fractions. Children will work on comparing units of measure and converting between units. Times tables will be given to be learnt at home and children's learning will be tested weekly.

## Science



Children will learn about Light in the first half term. They will learn about the sun and investigate how light rays travel in straight lines and how shadows are formed.

In the second half term, the children will learn about the properties of different materials. They will investigate the processes of melting, freezing and evaporation.



## Spanish



Children will develop the knowledge to day to day words to do with the date- months, numbers and simple phrases. They will study Spanish Phonics.

## History

Children will delve into the history of WW2. They will learn about the Battle of Britain/ Blitz and its affect in Britain as well as D day and its affect in the West Country. There will be a trip to the Fleet Air Arm Museum and an evacuee experience to Nothe Fort this term.

# Autumn 1 Willow Class

## RE



Children will learn about Judaism in the first half term and Hinduism later in the term. They will learn about traditions and beliefs and compare to their own.

Music - The children will follow the Charanga Scheme to work on music that is HAPPY themed. They will use listening skills and composing skills.
