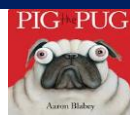

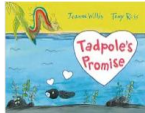
Over the first few weeks, the children will begin by reading Pig the Pug by Aaron Blabey and will use this text to write a guide on how to look after a pet. We will focus on writing an introduction to our guide and organising our ideas using headings and subheadings.



We will also read How to Be a Lion and use it to support writing a non-chronological report all about lions.



Later in the term, we will explore Tadpole's Promise by Jeanne Willis. The children will draw story maps, re-enact sections of the story and consider the thoughts and feelings of the characters at different points. This will support them in planning and writing their own version of the narrative.



The children will have daily SPaG lessons linked to their weekly spellings.

Whole class reading will take place each morning, where we will continue reading The Ancient Egyptian Sleepover.

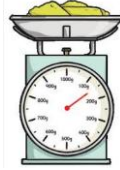

Children will be focusing on mental maths, number sense, measurements and fractions this term.

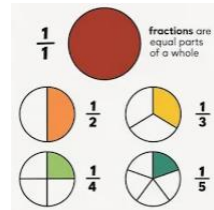
Measurement: Mass, Capacity and Temperature

Science

In Science this term we will be learning all about animals including humans. The children will match different offspring with their parents and look at a variation of life cycles for different organisms. The children will look at the different stages of a human and suggest what humans need to survive. We will explore what exercise; a balanced diet and good hygiene can do to improve our health.



Geography

We will be learning about the 7 continents and 5 oceans and where they are in the world. We will also look at the north and south poles, Antarctica, the deserts and the equator.



Spanish

We will be learning 10 classroom items in Spanish.



DT

The children will develop their designing and sewing skills by creating a superhero pouch from felt. They will design templates, create patterns and use simple sewing techniques such as running stitch to make their pouches fit for a superhero.



PE

PE is taught on a Friday afternoon with Miss Cook and a Thursday morning with Miss Davies the sports coach. This half term we will focus on Tennis and Cricket. We will be learning how to move with the racket and control a ball, sending and passing a ball with increasing accuracy.

Art

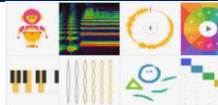
